(Santa Rosa, CA) The Charles M. Schulz Museum is celebrating the **50th anniversary of *You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown* on Saturday, March 4, from 10:00 am to 5:00 pm** with live performances of songs from the musical and appearances by Snoopy and

Charlie Brown. **Anyone who has ever voiced or played one of the *Peanuts* characters gets free admission all day!**

At 11:00 am, the cast from the [Pacifica Spindrift Players](#) will perform songs from the musical. Performers from the [Roustabout Theater](#) will sing “My New Philosophy” and “The Kite” at 1:30 and 2:30 pm.

Snoopy and Charlie Brown will be available for photos from 1:00 – 3:00 pm.

The day will conclude with a 3:30 pm airing of the 1985 animated version of *You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown*.

This event is being offered in conjunction with the Schulz Museum's newest exhibition, *You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown*, on view from February 23 to July 16, 2017. The exhibition celebrates the long-running success of this acclaimed stage production and features rare items, including original production scripts filled with handwritten notations and drawings, playbills and programs from worldwide performances, original musical score sheets, and cast photographs.
