

It's homecoming at Charlie Brown's school, and Charlie Brown and Linus are among the escorts for the Homecoming Queen and her court. During the Homecoming Parade, Linus tells Charlie Brown that he will be the escort for the Queen, but Charlie Brown is shocked when he sees the Queen is none other than the Little Red-Haired Girl herself. He is even more shocked when Linus tells him about the Homecoming tradition—that he has to escort Heather and give her a kiss on the cheek before the first dance. This may be Charlie Brown's chance to finally kiss the girl of his dreams.

This Emmy Award-nominated special finds the *Peanuts* Gang outfitted in costumes, ready for trick or treating and Violet's Halloween party. 1:00 pm • Social Commentary in *The Simpsons*

Join writers and producers Matt Selman, Tim Long, Mike Price, Tom Gammill and Max Pross as they share stories about working on *The Simpsons*, and discuss how social commentary often slips into an episode. Writing for the longest-running scripted show in television history, they've seen politically incorrect jokes become correct, and then incorrect again.

3:00 pm • You're Not Elected, Charlie Brown

In this Emmy Award-nominated special, Linus runs for student body president with Lucy and Charlie Brown as campaign managers. He takes an early lead in the polls but suffers a set back when he mentions the Great Pumpkin. Will he blow his chances with voters? This special features the first time Snoopy makes an appearance as his "Joe Cool" alter ego.
