

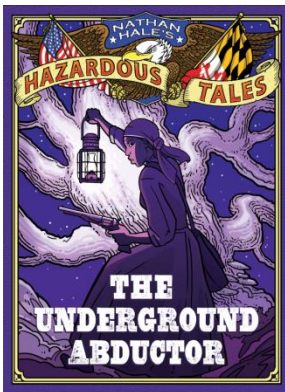

Award-winning Cartoonist, Nathan Hale,

Sunday, June 21, 2015 at 2:00 pm

at the Charles M. Schulz Museum

(Santa Rosa, CA) Award-winning cartoonist, illustrator, and author, **Nathan Hale**, will speak about his work, meet visitors and sign books at **2:00 pm on Sunday, June 21** and will be teaching a week-long class for young, aspiring cartoonists for five days: June 22 – 26, from 9:00 am – 12:30 pm.

Nathan Hale is the creator of the new series ***Nathan Hale's Hazardous Tales*** from Amulet Books. Hale is also the illustrator of several children's books and the Eisner-nominated graphic novel ***Rapunzel's Revenge***, which was an AI Roker Book Club for Kids selection, CYBIL Award winner, an ALA Notable Book, a YALSA Great Graphic Novel for Teens, and earned three starred reviews. In addition to speaking at the Museum for the general public, Hale will be teaching a week-long class for young, aspiring cartoonists. In his **Cartoon Boot Camp**, which meets for five days June 22 – 26, from 9:00 am – 12:30 pm at the Schulz Museum, students entering fourth grade and above will learn all the basics of writing and drawing comics from single panel jokes to starting a graphic novel,. This class will cover character design, panel layouts, visual gags, action scenes, and everything the young artist needs to know to tell stories in the comic format. Nathan Hale's Hazardous Tales is a fun graphic novel approach to true stories from the United States told from the point of view of Nathan Hale – the real life spy – who has been given the gift of insight into the country's history right before being hung as a spy. He's joined on his journey by a comical hangman who was about to hang Nathan Hale, as well as a stoic British Provost who was to witness the hanging. In order to prevent himself from being hung in the gallows, he must regale the two men with true tales from America's history.
