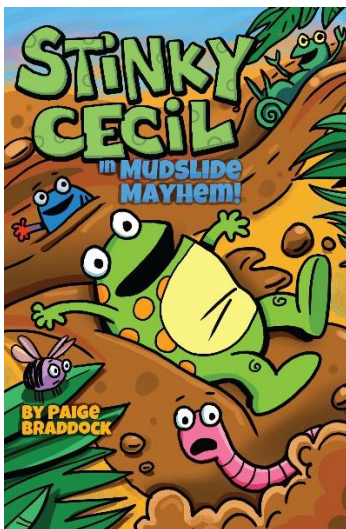

Braddock is the Creative Director at Charles M. Schulz Creative Associates. Braddock had the opportunity to train under

Schulz, her childhood hero, prior to his retirement. She has illustrated several *Peanuts* children's books, the Snoopy U.S. postage stamp issued in 2001, and the *Newsweek* cover featuring Charlie Brown following Schulz's retirement in 1999.
