### Accessible Tours Day at the Charles M. Schulz Museum and Research Center September 23, 2018

SANTA ROSA, Calif. August 27, 2018—On Sunday, September 23, the Charles M. Schulz Museum will hold an Accessible Tours Day with specialized tours at 10:30 am, 11:30 am, and 12:30 pm for blind, low-vision, deaf, and hard of hearing visitors. Included with the price of general admission, options include guided verbal description and tactile tours for blind and low-vision visitors and ASL-interpreted docent-led tours for the deaf and hard of hearing community.

This is the second Accessible Tours Day at the Schulz Museum following the first event last May. The Museum is exploring options to continue offering specialized tours in the future.

“The comic strip and *Peanuts* in general are such universal topics,” School and Public Programs Coordinator Monica Hernandez said. “It is the intention of the Schulz Museum

that everyone who comes through its doors feels just as at home in the Museum as the rest of the *Peanuts* Gang, and that means being accessible and inclusive to people of all abilities.”

Current exhibitions during this event include *Then Came the Dog*, exploring the life of Snoopy, and *Working Dogs*, a celebration of the four-legged heroes as Schulz portrayed them in *Peanuts*. Tours vary by group.
