### **ONLINE WORKSHOPS**

#### CARTOONING IN YOUR CLASSROOM

RECOMMENDED FOR GRADES 1 AND UP

This live, interactive experience includes an introduction to Charles M. Schulz, *Peanuts*, and the Schulz Museum, followed by a guided drawing of several of Schulz's most

popular characters. Learn to draw Snoopy and other *Peanuts* characters along with the basics of drawing different emotions and using the visual language of cartoons to tell stories.
