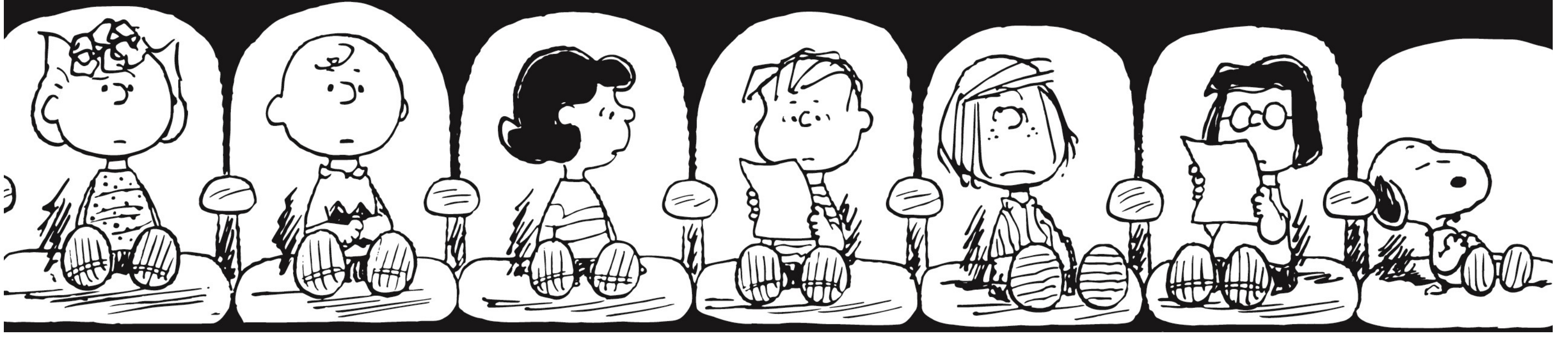

The *Peanuts* Gang travels from England to America in 1620 and experiences the first Thanksgiving.
Originally aired October 21, 1988 • 30 minutes
- 10:45 AM** **Snoopy's Reunion** 
Charlie Brown hosts a reunion for Snoopy and his family. Snoopy's brother, Andy, is the only *Peanuts* character to make their debut in an animated special before appearing in the comic strip. This film is being shown in conjunction with the exhibition *Drawn from Life*.
Originally aired May 1, 1991 • 30 minutes
- 11:15 AM** **You're in the Super Bowl, Charlie Brown!** 
Charlie Brown and his friends compete in a football punt, pass, and kick contest for tickets to the Super Bowl—will they score them? Franklin receives his last name in this animated special, as referenced in the exhibition *Drawn from Life*.

- 11:45 AM** **A Charlie Brown Thanksgiving** 
followed by Popcorn & Jellybeans: Making a Thanksgiving Classic
Snoopy and Linus help Charlie Brown cook their own version of a Thanksgiving meal for their friends. Followed by a documentary on the making of the *Peanuts* Thanksgiving special.

- 12:45 PM** **TV Land Legends: The 60 Minutes Interview**
Charles M. Schulz discusses the 50th anniversary of *Peanuts*.

- 1:15 PM** **A Charlie Brown Thanksgiving** 
Snoopy and Linus help Charlie Brown cook their own version of a Thanksgiving meal for their friends.
Originally aired November 20, 1973 • 30 minutes

- 2:00 PM** **Snoopy Come Home** 
Snoopy is forced to choose between Lila, his former owner, and Charlie Brown.
Originally aired in 1972 • 80 minutes
- 3:30 PM** **You're in Love, Charlie Brown** 
Charlie Brown agonizes over the Little Red-Haired Girl—will he finally talk to her? This is the first animated special in which adults are voiced using a trombone, as referenced in the exhibition *Adults by Schulz*.
Originally aired June 12, 1967 • 30 minutes
- 4:00 PM** **The Charlie Rose Interview**
In this interview with Charlie Rose, Charles Schulz discusses his personal history, the history of *Peanuts*, and the strip's 50th anniversary.
Originally aired May 9, 1997 • 40 minutes
