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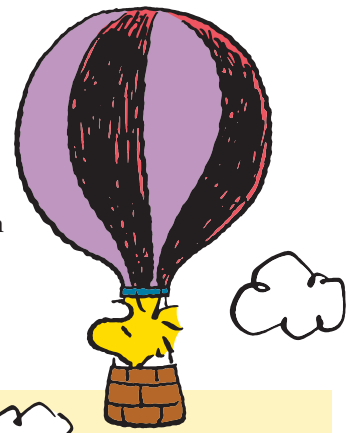

IN-PERSON PROGRAMS

PRE-K–2ND GRADE

WHO IS SNOOPY?

Enjoy a hands-on tour, watch a *Peanuts* animated special, play drawing games, and color cartoons.

1ST–6TH GRADE

THE CREATIVE PROCESS

Explore the creation of a comic strip. Apply imagination and collaborative brainstorming as younger students create comic stories and older students make stop-motion animated movies.

2ND–4TH GRADE

LOCAL HERO: THE STORY OF CHARLES M. SCHULZ

Explore Schulz's life and impact on local history, and learn to draw some of your favorite *Peanuts* characters.

3RD GRADE AND UP

THE ART OF THE STORY

Explore the elements of a story and create your own in a hands-on cartoon workshop.

3RD GRADE AND UP

THE ART OF CARTOONING

Learn how cartoonists use simple lines to show complex emotions. Create an animation sequence and watch it come to life in our giant zoetropes.

6TH GRADE AND UP

CHARACTER CREATION WORKSHOP

Develop your own characters and stories, and work in groups to explore stop-motion animation.

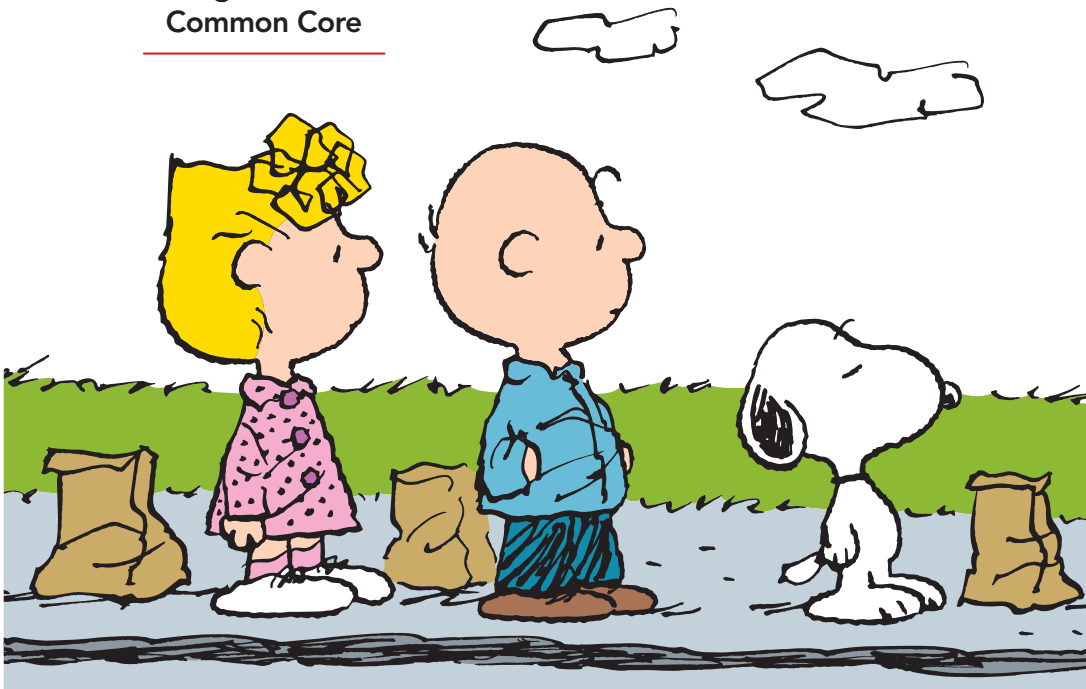

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CLASSROOM VISIT PROGRAMS

PRE-K–2ND GRADE

PEANUTS ON THE GO

Explore Schulz's world-famous *Peanuts* comic strip with hands-on crafts. Make Snoopy ears, puppets, and more.

3RD–5TH GRADE

TO THE MOON, SNOOPY!

Discover Snoopy's connection to NASA. Make a constellation viewer, straw rockets, and a lunar lander.

3RD–6TH GRADE

THE CREATIVE PROCESS

Apply imagination and collaborative brainstorming to create comic strips, and short stop-motion movies.

3RD–6TH GRADE

CARTOONING IN YOUR CLASSROOM

Use pictures and animation to tell stories. Create a zoetrope sequence, stop motion animation, and thaumatrope.

TIME 60–75 minutes per classroom
(depending on class schedule)

FEE

- \$150.00 for one class (maximum of 34 students)
- \$275.00 for two classes on same day
- \$375.00 for three classes on same day
- \$475.00 for four classes on same day

PEANUTS NATURALLY FESTIVALS

SCHOOL- OR GRADE-WIDE

- Serves up to 150 students at a time with hands-on science or art activities at your location.
- Museum provides staff, activities, and materials.
- School or site provides space, tables, and 10–15 volunteers.

K–6TH GRADE

PEANUTS NATURALLY ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE FESTIVAL

Learn about the environment with up to 15 fun, nature-related interactive exhibits—create a constellation viewer, launch rockets, excavate the past, and more.

K–2ND GRADE

PEANUTS NATURALLY ART FESTIVAL

Experiment with animation, origami, watercolor, pointillism, architecture, collage, color mixing, and more.

TIME 45-90 minutes per session (up to 5 sessions per day)

Offered on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday only

FEE \$750.00 for one day

PLUS Roundtrip mileage traveled from the Museum*

EARLY BIRD FEE \$600.00 for one day for a festival between September and December

Reservations should be made at least three weeks in advance.
